A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to remove the Disability of Aliens to hold Land Title. in New Zealand.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Aliens Act, 1870."

2. Every alien friend resident in New Zealand may inherit or Alien friend may hold otherwise take by representation, acquire hold convey assign devise real and personal bequeath or otherwise dispose of, every description of property, whether real or personal, in the same manner as if he were a natural-born subject of Her Majesty.

3. Every grant conveyance assignment demise devise or bequest, to Former conveyances or by any such alien, made prior to the passing of this Act, shall be as by aliens legalized. valid and effectual as if it had been made to or by a natural-born subject of Her Majesty.
