An Acr to apply a Sum of Money out of the Consolidated Fund and Title. other Moneys to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first day of March, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this present Session.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN, -- We, Your Majesty's most Address. dutiful and loyal subjects, the House of Representatives of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Appropriation Act, 1886." Short Title.

All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in Schedule A annexed hereto out of the Consolidated Fund amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to two millions three hundred and forty-one thousand five hundred and ninety-eight pounds, together with the fees collected by such public officers as are authorized to retain the same in lieu of salary, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the several votes in the Schedules B and C annexed hereto.

And whereas by the eleventh section of "The Public Trust Office Act, 1872," it is enacted that the salary of the Public Trustee and of the other officers and servants in the Public Trust Office shall be such as shall be fixed by the General Assembly: Be it enacted that the said salaries, and contingencies, for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, shall be for the amounts set forth in Schedule E annexed hereto, not exceeding in the whole the sum of five thousand nine hundred and nine pounds.

Provision for salaries, &c., in Insurance Department, £26,582.

6. And whereas by the thirty-ninth section of "The Government Insurance and Annuities Act, 1874," and the fourth section of "The Government Life Insurance Act, 1886," re-enacting the same, it is provided that the salary of the Commissioner and other officers and other contingent expenses shall be paid out of moneys from time to time appropriated from the Government Insurance Account for the purpose by the General Assembly: Be it enacted, the said salaries and expenses for the period ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, shall be for the amounts set forth in the Schedule F annexed hereto, not exceeding in the whole the sum of twenty-six thousand five hundred and eighty-two pounds.

And whereas the Colonial Treasurer has, under the authority Indomnity. of section forty-four of "The Public Revenues Act, 1878," issued during the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, in excess of or without the appropriation of Parliament, the sum of seventy thousand four hundred and three pounds and fourpence from the Consolidated Fund, and a further sum of six pounds eleven shillings and twopence from the Public Trust Office Expenses Account, and has discharged from the accounts the sum of four hundred and ninety-six pounds ten shillings and fourpence due to but irrecoverable by the Crown, and has caused the said sums to be applied to the several purposes and services mentioned in the Schedule G hereto annexed: Be it enacted that the application and discharge of the said sums is hereby sanctioned.

9. For the purposes of this section the expression "local governing body" means a County Council, Borough Council, Town Board, Road Board, River Board, and an Education Board, and includes any other body or persons however designated to whom any moneys are paid or payable out of the Consolidated Fund.
