A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Akitio County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Akitio County Act, 1898." Short Title.
- 2. The Akitio County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise Constitution of Akitio County. that portion of the Wairarapa North County particularly described in the Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the Wairarapa North County are hereby altered accordingly.
- 10 3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and Jurisdiction of County Council. during the subsistence of the county hereby constituted, no local body or authority other than the County Council shall, within the limits of the said county, be created, or exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads, or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect
- 15 of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of "The Counties Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof, or otherwise.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the County of Wairarapa North comprised in the Akitio Road District, as existing at the end of June, 1898, commencing at Wahatuara Trig. Station, and going easterly. Bounded generally towards the north by the Waipawa County to the sea; and bounded generally on the east by the sea to the boundary of the Castlepoint Road District; towards the south by the Castlepoint Road District; towards the west by the Castlepoint Road District and Alfredton Riding Outlying District to the boundary of the Pahiatua County; and thence in a northerly direction by the Pahiatua County to the point of commencement.
