Title.	2. Section 48 of principal Act (contributions to funds by local authorities) amended.
1. Short Title.	

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Auckland Centennial Memorial Park Act, 1941. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Centennial Memorial Park Amendment Act, 1947. Short Title.

2. The Auckland Centennial Memorial Park Act, 1941, is hereby amended by adding to section forty-eight thereof the following subsection:— Section 48 of principal Act (contributions to funds by local authorities) amended.

“(5) Any local authority may by special order and without taking the steps prescribed by sections nine to thirteen of the Local Bodies’ Loans Act, 1926, but subject to the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, raise a special loan for the purpose of making a grant or contribution towards the funds of the Board for the extension, development, or improvement of the Auckland Centennial Memorial Park.”
