A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Auckland Electric-power Board Act, 1921-22. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Electric-power Board Amendment Act, 1926, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Auckland Electric-power Board Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

10 2. (1.) Section eighty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "installation thereof" ~~in line five~~, the following words: "together with interest at the rate of six per centum per annum on the total sum until payment thereof," and by adding thereto the following subsections:— Amendment of section 89 of the principal Act.

15 (2.) Without prejudice to provisions of the preceding paragraph subsection and the charge thereby created the Board may, within six months from the time when the amount payable under such preceding paragraph subsection has been ascertained, cause a notice of such charge under the hand of the Clerk to be registered against the title to such land, whether under the Land Transfer Act, 1915, or not.

20 (3.) Every notice under this section shall be accepted for registration by the District Land Registrar or other proper officer.

(4.) On full satisfaction of such charge the Board shall register a notice of such satisfaction.
