An Act to vary the Powers of the Trustees of the Auckland Girls' Title. High School Endowment for borrowing Moneys for the Purposes of such School.

5 WHEREAS a reserve of four thousand eight hundred and ninety- Preamble. eight acres of land in the Maungaru Survey District, Auckland, has been set apart as an endowment for the Auckland Girls' High School, and, the said school being subject to "The High Schools Reserves Act, 1881" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), the powers of 10 leasing contained in section six of the said Act are not suitable for

the leasing of the aforesaid reserve, the principal value whereof consists of the timber on the land comprised therein: And whereas it is expedient to vary the powers of the Trustees of the said reserve for the leasing thereof: And whereas the said reserve is vested in the

15 Education Board of the District of Auckland which has the control of the aforesaid school under the authority of "The Auckland Girls' High School Act, 1878:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as **20** follows :-

1. The Short Title of the Act is "The Auckland Girls' High Short Title. School Act, 1887."

2. The Education Board of the District of Auckland (hereinafter Trustees may borreferred to as "the Board"), in whom the above-mentioned reserve is row \$5,000 for construction of vested, as Trustees thereof, in addition to their powers under the said brick school Act, for the purpose of providing a sum of money not exceeding five buildings. thousand pounds, to be expended in the construction of brick buildings at Auckland for the Girls' High School, on the site reserved for such purpose,—

May borrow, from time to time interest not exceeding seven per centum per annum, such sums of money as they shall think requisite, not exceeding the sum herein above mentioned; and may grant to the person or persons lending the same a pledge upon the rents and profits of all or any part of the land reserved in the Maungaru 10 Survey District as above mentioned, and on the proceeds of the timber thereon; and also may grant to the said person or persons one or more mortgages, with a power of sale, upon all or any part of the site reserved in Auckland where the high school is to be erected, with the buildings 15 thereon, in such form and subject to such conditions, and with such powers and provisions, as the said Board may
