A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to transfer certain Land in the City of Auckland, being Part of the Auckland Gaol Reserve, to the Auckland Grammar School Board as a Site for a Secondary School. Title.

5 WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is part of the Auckland Gaol Reserve, but is no longer required therefor: And whereas it is desired to transfer the said land to the Auckland Grammar School Board as a site for a secondary school on the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing: Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Grammar School Site Act, 1911. Short Title.

15 2. The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby vested in the Auckland Grammar School Board, in trust as a site for a secondary school, subject to the provisions of this Act. Land vested in Auckland Grammar School Board.

3. (1.) The said Board shall cause to be erected on the said land buildings suitable and necessary for the purposes of such school, to the satisfaction of the Minister of Education. Board to erect buildings for secondary school.

(2.) No building shall be erected on the said land except according to plans and in a manner approved by the said Minister.

20 (3.) Unless within ten years from the passing of this Act the said Board has erected buildings as aforesaid, the Governor may by Proclamation resume possession of such land, and the land shall, as from the date of that Proclamation, revert to the Crown.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Borough of Mount Eden, containing by admeasurement ~~15 14~~ acres ~~± 3~~ roods ~~342 6.5~~ perches, more or less, being parts of Allotments Nos. 106, 107, 108, and 109, Section No. 6, Suburbs of Auckland: bounded towards the south-east by Mountain Road from its junction with Firth Road, for a distance of ~~345.77~~ 292.17 links: thence towards the south-west by lines bearing 313° 54', ~~106.4~~ 127.93 links; 308° 50', ~~456.18~~ 465.89 links; 291° 46', ~~527.61~~ 483.46 links: thence towards the north-west generally by lines bearing 23° 37', ~~597.82~~ 237.71 links; 293° 37', 50 links; 23° 37', 308.46 links; 352° 6', 59.22 links; 73° 22' 39", 154.8 links; 73° 2' 22", 757.63 links; 55° 50', 129.5 links; 10° 46', 576.83 links: thence towards the north-east by a line bearing 103° 42', 494.35 links, to Firth Road: and towards the east generally by Firth Road, 398.8, 758.2, 291.58, and 521.86 links, to the place of commencement.
