A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Auckland Harbour Board to Transfer to Title. the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Devonport a certain Piece of Land within the Borough of

Devonport, as a Recreation-ground for the Use of the Public. 5

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Auckland Harbour Board short Title.

Empowering Act, 1894."

- 2. It shall be lawful for the Auckland Harbour Board and it is Board empowered 10 hereby empowered to convey and assure unto the Mayor, Councillors, to convey land to and Burgesses of the Borough of Devonport, in fee-simple, all that Devonport. piece or parcel of land situate within the Borough of Devonport particularly described in the Schedule hereto, for the use of the public
- 15 as a place of public recreation, to be held by them under and subject to the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof relating to places of public recreation.
