A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Auckland Harbour Board to borrow the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds for harbour works and other purposes. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Harbour Board Loan and Empowering Act 1953. Short Title.
- 10 2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act 1950. Special Act.
3. The Board is hereby authorized, subject to the provisions of the Harbours Act 1950, to construct and carry out the harbour works specified in the *First* Authority to carry out harbour works.
- 15 Schedule to this Act.
4. It shall be lawful for the Board, from time to time as it may require, to borrow, subject to the provisions of the Harbours Act 1950 and the Local Authority to borrow.

2 *Auckland Harbour Board Loan and Empowering*

Government Loans Board Act 1926, a sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds.

Reimbursement
of Harbour
Fund. 6. The Board is hereby authorized to refund to the
Harbour Fund, from the moneys borrowed under the
authority of this Act, the amount of any moneys 10
expended from the Harbour Fund, whether before or
after the passing of this Act, in the carrying out or
construction of any of the harbour works or other
purposes specified in the *Second* Schedule to this Act,
and any amount so refunded shall be deemed to have 15
been applied and expended for that purpose.
