## A BILL INTITULED

- An Act to authorize the Auckland Harbour Board to Title. borrow the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds for harbour works and other purposes.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
  - 1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Harbour Short Title. Board Loan and Empowering Act 1953.
- 2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act special Act. within the meaning of the Harbours Act 1950.
- 3. The Board is hereby authorized, subject to the Authority to provisions of the Harbours Act 1950, to construct and carry out carry out the harbour works specified in the First 15 Schedule to this Act.
  - 4. It shall be lawful for the Board, from time to Authority to time as it may require, to borrow, subject to the provisions of the Harbours Act 1950 and the Local

Government Loans Board Act 1926, a sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one million six hundred thousand pounds.

Expenditure on harbour works.

5. All moneys borrowed under and by the authority of this Act shall be applied and expended in the construction of the harbour works and for the other purposes specified in the *First* Schedule to this Act.

Reimbursement of Harbour Fund. 6. The Board is hereby authorized to refund to the Harbour Fund, from the moneys borrowed under the authority of this Act, the amount of any moneys 10 expended from the Harbour Fund, whether before or after the passing of this Act, in the carrying out or construction of any of the harbour works or other purposes specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, and any amount so refunded shall be deemed to have 15 been applied and expended for that purpose.
