A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Auckland Institute Act, 1875."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Auckland Institute Act Amendment Act, 1876." Short Title.

2. So much of section 3 of "The Auckland Institute Act, 1875," as follows the words "as such mortgagor," is hereby repealed. Repeal of part of section 3 of Act of 1875.

3. The powers conferred by the said Act upon the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland may be exercised, subject to the provisions of the said Act, by any person appointed by the Governor in Council for that purpose. Powers of Superintendent may be exercised by appointee of Governor.
