A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act, Title.  
1893."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Short Title.  
Control Act Amendment Act, 1897."

2. The grant of a publican's or accommodation license in any  
10 district in respect of premises in respect whereof a similar license is  
not previously in force shall, unless such grant shall be in pursuance  
of the removal of such license according to law, be deemed to be an  
increase in the number of licenses for such district.
