A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1897." Short Title.

2. Section four of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," is hereby repealed. Section 4, "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," repealed.

3. On the first Wednesday in the month of December, one thousand nine hundred and one, and on the same day in every fifth year thereafter, a poll of the electors in each electoral district shall be taken upon the proposals to be submitted to them under "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895": Poll to be taken.
Provided that no poll which is taken in any district shall be valid unless at least one-half of the total number of electors on the roll of the district shall have recorded their votes.

4. Section twenty of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," is hereby repealed. Section 20, "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," repealed.
