2. No debt of ten pounds or under shall be recoverable by Certain debts not 2. No debt of ten pounds or under snan be recoverable by process of law by any assignee thereof either in his own name or in Assignee. the name of the creditor: Provided, however, that nothing in this Proviso. Act contained shall apply to debts vesting in the Official Assignee, nor to debts assigned as part of and along with the other assets of an estate or business.
