A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Animals Protection Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Animals Protection Act, 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Animals Protection Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. (1.) Land may be taken by the Governor under the Public Works Act, 1908, as a sanctuary for imported or native game or for the breeding and preservation of such game in the same manner in all respects as if such land were taken for a public work under that Act.

Sanctuaries for game to be Government works.

(2.) Land taken or acquired for any of the said purposes may be let for such term of years at such rents and subject to such conditions as the Governor in each case thinks fit.
