A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same 5 as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Auckland Regional Authority Amendment Act 1971, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal 10 Act").

2. Auckland Centennial Memorial Park—(1) Section 44 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsections (6) and (7).

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into force 15 on the 1st day of November 1971.



3. Unauthorised expenditure—(1) Section 55 of the principal Act (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "four thousand dollars", and substituting the words "the maximum sum for the time being permitted for 5 such purposes in the case of a Borough Council by virtue of the provisions of section 92 of the Public Revenues Act 1953, or of any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof or of any other enactment."

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into force 10 on the 1st day of April 1971.
