A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to validate and confirm certain regulations made
under the authority of the Agriculture (Emergency
Powers) Act 1934**

5 WHEREAS by section 27 of the Agriculture (Emergency
Powers) Act 1934 it is provided that all regulations made
under the authority of that section shall be laid before Par-
liament and shall expire on the close of the last day of the
session in which they are so laid before Parliament except
10 so far as they are expressly validated or confirmed by an
Act of Parliament passed during that session: And whereas
the regulations specified in section 2 of this Act have been
made under the authority of the Agriculture (Emergency
Powers) Act 1934 and have been laid before Parliament
15 during the present session, and it is desired to validate and
confirm those regulations:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of
New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:

2 *Agriculture (Emergency Regulations Confirmation)*

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Agriculture (Emergency Regulations Confirmation) Act 1969.

2. Regulations confirmed—The Milk Treatment Regulations 1969 are hereby declared to be valid and are hereby confirmed as required by section 27 of the Agriculture 5 (Emergency Powers) Act 1934.
