

AGRICULTURE (EMERGENCY REGULATIONS CONFIRMATION) BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill validates and confirms certain regulations made under section 27 of the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934. Subsections (5) and (6) of that section require all such regulations to be laid before Parliament within 16 sitting days after they are made, and provide that they expire at the end of the session during which they are laid before Parliament unless validated and confirmed by an Act of Parliament passed during that session.

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title.

Clause 2 validates and confirms the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 4, and the Dairy Board (Local Marketing) Regulations 1987. The sole effect of the former regulations was to revoke the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 3, which have been replaced by the Dairy Industry (Fees) Regulations 1986. The latter regulations revoked the Butter and Cheese Marketing Regulations 1948 (one subclause of which had been made under the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934), and replaced them with a provision that gives the New Zealand Dairy Board power to buy and sell butter and cheese on the local market.

Clause 3 revokes the Agriculture (Emergency Regulations Confirmation) Act (No. 2) 1985, which is now spent.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to validate and confirm certain regulations made under section 27 of the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934

5 BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Agriculture (Emergency Regulations Confirmation) Act 1987.

2. Confirmation—The following regulations are hereby validated and confirmed:

- 10 (a) The Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 4*:
(b) The Dairy Board (Local Marketing) Regulations 1987†.

3. Repeal—The Agriculture (Emergency Regulations Confirmation) Act (No. 2) 1986 is hereby repealed.
