A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Auckland University College Act, 1882. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland University College Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1912. Short Title.

2. Section six of the Auckland University College Act, 1882, is hereby amended as follows:— Amendment of section 6 of principal Act.

10 (a.) By repealing the word "eleven," and substituting in lieu thereof the word "twelve":

(b.) By adding, after the words "Education Board of the District of Auckland," the words "another shall be elected by the Professorial Board at its first meeting in the month of March in each year, the first such election to be held in the month of March, nineteen hundred and thirteen":

15 (c.) By inserting at the end of the said section the words "unless elected by the Professorial Board under the provision hereinbefore contained."

20 3. (1.) The Council may from time to time prescribe reasonable fees for the attendance of students at lectures and classes. Such fees shall be paid to the Registrar of the College. Fees.

(2.) The Council may, at its discretion, pay to the professors or lecturers, or any of them, the aforesaid fees or any part or 25 proportion thereof.

4. Section twenty-four of the Auckland University College Act, 1882, is hereby repealed. Repeal.
