## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Bank-note Issue Act, 1893," and to Title. prohibit, unless with the Consent of Parliament, Amalgamation by the Bank of New Zealand.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Banking Act, 1894."

Short Title. 2. The words "by at least the sum of the paid-up capital," in Amendment of the first proviso to section five of "The Bank-note Issue Act, 1893," "The Bank-note Issue Act, 1893," "Issue Act, 1893." 10 are hereby repealed.

3. It shall not be lawful for the Bank of New Zealand to amal- Prohibition of gamate with any other banking company or corporation, whether by amalgamation of Bank of New way of purchase or sale of assets and business or otherwise howsoever, Zealand. without the consent of Parliament.
