A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Bank Holidays Act, 1873." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Bank Holidays Short Title. 5 Amendment Act, 1878."

2. After the passing of this Act, the several days mentioned in Bank holidays. the Schedule to this Act shall be bank holidays; and sections two, three, and four of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1873," shall apply to those days.

10 3. It shall be lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to Bank half-holidays. appoint part of a special day, from the hour of noon, to be observed as a bank half-holiday; the appointment to be made in the manner in which special days may be appointed as bank holidays under the provisions of section five of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1873."

The twenty-fifth day of December. Good Friday. The day after Good Friday. Whit-Monday.
The ninth day of November. The seventeenth day of January.
