A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Bluff Harbour Board Act, 1876."
Title.

WHEREAS since the passing of "The Bluff Harbour Board Act, 1876," certain districts at the time of the passing of the said Act forming part of the Invercargill Road District have, by virtue of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," been constituted municipalities under the respective names of East Invercargill, South Invercargill, North Invercargill, Avenal, and Gladstone: And whereas it is expedient to make provision for retaining the original boundaries of the electorate of Invercargill Road Board formed under "The Bluff Harbour Board Act, 1876:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Bluff Harbour Board Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1878."
Short Title.

2. For the purposes of "The Bluff Harbour Board Act, 1876," and any election to be held thereunder, the said Municipalities of East Invercargill, South Invercargill, North Invercargill, Avenal, and Gladstone, and any municipality hereafter to be created within the present boundaries of the Invercargill Road District shall be deemed to be within the Invercargill Road District, and the ratepayers of the said municipalities shall be entitled to vote in the same manner as if they were ratepayers of the said Road Board.
