BLUFF HARBOUR BOARD EMPOWERING.

[Local Bill.]

ANALYSIS.

Title. Preamble. 1. Short Title. 2. Bluff Harbour Board may sell land described in Schedule.

3. Application of proceeds.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to empower the Bluff Harbour Board to Sell Sections Title. Four and Five of Block Twelve in the Town of Campelltown, and to apply the Net Proceeds thereof in the Purchase of other Land for an Endowment for the Board.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule is vested in the Preamble. Bluff Harbour Board (constituted under "The Harbours Act, 1878," and hereinafter referred to as "the Board,") for the purpose of offices for the use of the Board: And whereas the said land is 10 unsuitable for such purpose, and it is desirable to empower the Board to sell the same and to apply the net proceeds thereof in the purchase of other land to be held as an endowment for the Board:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

15 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Bluff Harbour Board Short Title.

Empowering Act, 1897."

2. The Board may sell the land described in the Schedule Bluff Harbour Board either by public auction or by private contract, and either in one lot may sell land described in 20 or in several lots, at such price or prices and upon such terms and Schedule. conditions as it shall think fit, and may execute all necessary or requisite instruments for conveying, assuring, and transferring the same to the purchaser or respective purchasers thereof, and for discharging him or them from payment of the purchase-money 25 payable by him or them.

3. After payment of all costs, charges, and expenses of and Application of incidental to such sale or sales, the net proceeds of such land shall proceeds. be paid and applied by the Board in the purchase of other land, which shall be held by the Board in trust as an endowment for the Board, 30 and may be dealt with by the Board in the manner prescribed by

"The Harbours Act, 1878," as to lands vested in it.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situated in the Town of Campbelltown containing by admeasurement 2 roods 4 perches, more or less, being Sections Nos. 4 and 5, Block XII., of the said town. Bounded towards the north by Sections Nos. 1, 6, and 3, of said block, 268 links; towards the south-east by Section No. 7, Block I., Campbelltown Hundred, 276 links; towards the south by Foyle Street, 151 links; and towards the west by Lee Street, 250 links.
