2. Board authorized to contribute to the cost of a shipping service.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Bluff Harbour Board to contribute to the Cost of running a Shipping Service between Bluff and Stewart Island. **Title.**

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Bluff Harbour Board Empowering Act, 1933. **Short Title.**

10 2. The Bluff Harbour Board is hereby authorized and empowered to pay in each of its financial years, and upon such conditions as it thinks fit, an amount not exceeding two hundred pounds to any person carrying on a shipping service for passengers and cargo between Bluff and Half-
15 moon Bay, Stewart Island. **Board authorized to contribute to the cost of a shipping service.**
