A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Bluff Harbour Board to reclaim from the Sea, in the Title. Bluff Harbour, a Portion of the Foreshore.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament 5 assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Bluff Harbour Foreshore Reclama-Short Title. tion Act, 1882."

 The Bluff Harbour Board are hereby authorized to reclaim from the sea, Reclamation of part in the Bluff Harbour, the portion of the foreshore in the said harbour described of Bluff Harbour foreshore.

Provided that the Minister for Public Works may take for railway purposes the land marked "Railway Reserve" on the plan referred to in the said Schedule.

3. This Act shall be deemed to be a Special Act within the meaning of "The Harbours Act, 1878," and all the provisions of that Act shall extend and apply to this Act.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing twelve acres, more or less, situated Schedule. on the foreshore of the Bluff Harbour, and commencing at a point five hundred and seventy links, at a bearing of two degrees from the extreme north-east corner

- of Block one in the Town of Campbelltown; thence one thousand and seventy 30 links, at a bearing of two hundred and seventy-nine degrees one minute; thence one hundred links, at a bearing of one hundred and ninety-eight degrees one minute; thence three thousand nine hundred and fifty links, at a bearing of two hundred and seventy-nine degrees one minute, to a point at high-water mark on the said foreshore opposite Section five, Block five, Campbelltown aforementioned;
- 35 thence five thousand three hundred links or thereabouts along high-water mark to the point of commencement, as the same is delineated on the plan marked M.D. 622A., deposited in the Marine Office, Wellington.
