Title. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable School Committees to cause the Bible to be Title. read in Schools.

WHEREAS it is expedient to give to School Committees the option 5 of causing the Bible to be read in schools, if they shall see fit:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Bible-reading in Schools Short Title. 10 Act, 1886."

2. It shall be lawful for the School Committee of any district Bible may be read constituted under the provisions of "The Education Act, 1877," if it in schools. shall see fit, anything in the said Act contained to the contrary notwithstanding, to direct that a portion of the Holy Scriptures shall

15 be read aloud by the scholars of one or other of the senior classes every morning at the opening of the school. Such reading shall not exceed twenty minutes, and no child shall be compelled to attend such reading if the parent or guardian of such child shall, in writing, inform the Committee or teacher that he objects to such 20 attendance.
