A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Council of the Borough of New Plymouth to Lease certain Building Sites. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to give the Borough Council of New Plymouth power to lease certain building sites Preamble. set forth in the Schedule hereto:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New ⁵ Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Borough of New Plymouth Building Sites Act, 1878."

2. It shall be lawful for the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of 10 the Borough of New Plymouth to lease, in manner provided by section The Borough one hundred and seventy-seven of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," the right to build over that portion of the Huatoki River described in the first and second parts of the Schedule hereto.

3. The rents and profits derived from the leasing of such sites 15 shall be vested in the Borough and form part of the Borough Fund.
