A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to define the Borough of Onehunga.

Preamble.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions in that behalf contained in
"The Special Powers and Contracts Act, 1881," a Crown grant was,
5 on the second day of October, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-
three, issued to the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough
of Onehunga, for all that piece of land described in the Schedule
hereto, in trust for the inhabitants of the Borough of Onehunga and
the County of Eden for a cemetery: And whereas the said piece of
10 land is situated within the boundaries of the Borough of Onehunga:
And whereas certain interments have taken place in the said piece of
land, and it is expedient that the said piece of land should be excluded
from the said borough:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
15 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Borough of Onehunga
Boundaries Alteration Act, 1892." Short Title.

20 2. The piece described in the Schedule hereto, as from the
second day of October, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three,
shall not be or be deemed to have been included within the bound-
aries of the Borough of Onehunga, and the description of the
boundaries of the said borough shall be read as if the said piece of
land were excepted therefrom. Alteration of

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, in the Colony of New
Zealand, containing by admeasurement 10 acres, more or less, situated in the
Otahuhu Survey District, and being southern portions of Sections Nos. 44, 45, and
46, and middle portion of Section No. 61, near the Town of Onehunga. Bounded
towards the north by the northern portion of Sections Nos. 61, 44, 45, and 46, 1570
links; towards the east and south by the Manukau Harbour; towards the west by
the southern portion of Section No. 61, 650 links; and towards the north-west by the
Manukau Harbour aforesaid, and the termination of a road 100 links: be all the
aforesaid linkages more or less.
