A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Bills of Sale Act 1867" and "The Mortgages of Stock Registration Act 1868." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Bills of Sale and Mortgages of Stock Registration Act 1869." Short Title.

2. In addition to the particular search against the names of specified persons which every person is by "The Bills of Sale Act 1867" authorized to make in respect of Bills of Sale filed in the Supreme Court every person shall be entitled to make a general search in respect of Bills of Sale and assignments thereof in the manner following The person desiring to make a general search shall state to the Registrar or Deputy Registrar the date from which he desires to make a general search such date not being in any case more than thirty days before the day upon which the said search is made The Registrar or Deputy Registrar shall thereupon open the book in which entries of the filing of Bills of Sale are made at the earliest entry of the filing of a Bill of Sale on or after the date so specified and shall suffer the person searching to inspect the said entry and all subsequent entries in the said book all previous entries being carefully concealed Every instrument referred to in the entries so inspected shall be produced to the person searching if he so desire and he shall be allowed to peruse the same and to have an office copy or extract of or from any and every such instrument and of or from the affidavit schedule and inventory thereto annexed upon paying for the same at the rate of four pence for every folio of seventy-two words contained in such copy or extract. General search may be made over a period not exceeding thirty days.

3. There shall be paid to the said Registrar or Deputy Registrar for every such general search a fee of two shillings for each and every separate entry (if any) contained in the said book for the period over which the said general search extends and if there shall be no such entry then a fee of two shillings only.
