BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Borough of Sydenham Short Title.

Endowment Act, 1891.'

2. The parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Act shall Vesting lands as 15 be and the same is hereby vested in and transferred to the Mayor, endowment for borough. Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Sydenham as an endowment for the benefit of the said borough, and may be used, subdivided, and leased in accordance with the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886."

ALL that parcel of land in the Borough of Sydenham, in the Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 4 acres, more or less, being part of Rural Section No. 72 on the map of the Chief Surveyor of the said Provincial District setting out and describing the rural lands in the Christchurch Survey District: Bounded on the north and north-west by Poulson Street, 453 links and 387 links respectively; on the west by lots Nos. 153 and 154, as shown on plan No. 63 deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Christchurch, 449 links; on the south by a watercourse known as Jackson's Creek; and on the east by a public road, as more particularly delineated and shown on the plan recorded on folium No. 81 of Register-book No. 16D. in the Deeds Registry Office at Christchurch.
