A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Provision made for the Registration of Title.
Barmaids.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Barmaids Registration Act, Short Title:
1912.

2. (1.) Subsection one of section thirty-six of the Licensing Section 36 of
10 Amendment Act, 1910, is hereby amended by inserting, after the Licensing
word "bar" where it first occurs, the words "or private bar." Amendment Act,
1910, amended.

(2.) The term "private bar" means any room, passage, or lobby
in any licensed premises wherein the public may enter and purchase
liquors, other than a public bar.
