A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Counties Act, 1886."

Title.

WHEREAS several road districts in the colony have by special Acts of Parliament been abolished, and in their places counties have
 5 been substituted: And whereas doubts have been raised as to whether by such abolition of road districts and creation of new counties the road districts were, in the meaning of section fifty-seven of "The Counties Act, 1886," merged in the counties: And it is expedient that such doubts should be set at rest:

Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Counties Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1895."

Short Title.

15 2. Every road district hitherto abolished by any Act of Parliament, and in substitution of which a county has been established, such road district shall have been merged in such county in the meaning of section fifty-seven of "The Counties Act, 1886."
