This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend "The Counties Act, 1886."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Counties Act Amend- shor ment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Counties Act, 1886" (hereinafter called "the principal Act").

2. No special order under section fifty-three of the principal Act Special order 10 merging any road district or town district shall have effect until it merging road district, &c., to be is gazetted; and that section is hereby modified accordingly.

3. (1.) A copy of every by-law made under section three hundred Power to disallow and eleven of the principal Act by a Council, providing for the by-law relating to vehicle-licensing. licensing of vehicles plying for hire, shall, within one week after the 15 making thereof, be sent by the Council to the Minister for Public Works.

(2.) The said Minister may at any time within two years thereafter disallow any such by-law or any part thereof, and on such disallowance being gazetted, the by-law or part thereof shall cease 20 to have effect; but such disallowance shall not affect the validity of anything theretofore done under the by-law or part thereof so disallowed.

(3.) Section three hundred and eleven of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words "But no by-laws appointing 25 the several sums" to the end of the section; and section two of "The Public Works and Government Railways Acts Amendment Act, 1895," is hereby amended by repealing the words "within twelve months" in paragraph (c) of subsection one, and substituting in-lieu-thereof the words "within-two-years."

5. Section two hundred and eighty-three of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting the words "and shall be maintained" after the word "used" in subsection one thereof.

6. It shall be an offence to erect or maintain any pig-sty or fowlhouse within twenty-five links of any public water-race: Provided such water-race is not within a goldfields district.

7. Any County Council may from time to time contribute out of the its general funds vote a any sum not exceeding thirty pounds in any one year to towards the maintenance or improvement of any cemetery vested in trustees within the county for cemetery improvement purposes.
