A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Customs Act, 1913.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act, 1924, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act, 1913.

Short Title.

2. (1.) There shall be payable on sugar of number 22 colour or over (Dutch Standard), and on invert sugar and invert syrup, imported into New Zealand or entered for home consumption on or after the first day of October, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, duties of Customs at the same rates as if such sugar, invert sugar, or invert syrup had been imported and entered for home consumption immediately before that date.

(2.) Part II of the Schedule to the Customs Amendment Act, 1923, is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from the reference to sugar, invert sugar, and invert syrup, as specified in the last preceding subsection, the words " up to and including 30th September, 1924," and the words " On and after 1st October, 1924," and also the word " Free " in each of the columns numbered 1, 2, and 3.
