A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Coal-mines Act, 1925. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority  
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Coal-mines Amendment Act, 1933, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Coal-mines Act, 1925. Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section  
10 thirty-nine of the Public Works Act, 1928, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Mines to demise, on such terms and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit, for any period not exceeding sixty years, any land taken under that Act for providing access to land subject to  
15 Part III of the Coal-mines Act, 1925, and the rents and profits thereof shall be paid into the Public Account to the credit of the State Coal-mines Account. Minister of Mines may demise certain lands.
