A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Counties Act 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Counties Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Counties Act 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Advances to organisations for purposes of public recreation, etc.—Section 319 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection (2), after the words "grants of money", the words "or make advances upon such terms and conditions as it thinks fit".
- 15 3. Subject-matter of bylaws—(1) Section 401 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (15), after the words "repair of buildings", the words "as defined in the bylaws".
- (2) Section 401 of the principal Act is hereby further 20 amended by repealing the proviso to paragraph (27), and substituting the following proviso:

"Provided that the licence fee for a hawker or pedlar who sells only perishable articles of human food shall not exceed one pound a year, and in the case of any other hawker or pedlar shall not exceed two pounds a year:".

(3) Section 401 of the principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after paragraph (27), the following

paragraph:

"(27A) Licensing and regulating the conduct of keepers of mobile or travelling shops (not being hawkers or pedlars or keepers of stalls), and imposing a licence fee not exceeding 10 twenty-five pounds a year:".

(4) Section 401 of the principal Act is hereby further

amended:

(a) By inserting in paragraph (28), after the words "hawkers or pedlars", the words "or keepers of 15 mobile or travelling shops":

(b) By inserting in paragraph (29), after the words "(including vehicles used as stalls)", the words "or of mobile or travelling shops".
