A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to restrict the Sale and Possession of Title.
Contraceptives.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Contraceptives Act, Short Title.
1932.

- 10 2. (1) Every person commits an offence who—
(a) Not being a registered chemist sells contraceptives Restricting sale
to any person other than a registered chemist and possession
for any other purpose than resale in the of contraceptives.
ordinary course of business :
15 (b) Whether a registered chemist or not sells or other-
wise disposes of contraceptives to any person
under the age of eighteen years :
(c) Being a person under the age of eighteen years has
contraceptives in his or her possession.
20 (2) Every person committing any offence as aforesaid
shall be liable on summary conviction—
(a) To a fine of *twenty* pounds in the case of a first
offence :

(b) To a fine of *one hundred* pounds or imprisonment for a term of *three* months in the case of a second or any subsequent offence.

Regulations.

3. The Governor-General may from time to time, by Order-in Council, make all such regulations as he deems necessary for the effectual carrying out of the object of this Act, and may prescribe fines not exceeding *twenty* pounds in any case for the breach of any such regulation. 5
