A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928.

Title.  
Preamble.

WHEREAS by an Act intituled the Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928, reference is erroneously made in the last line of section two thereof to section eight of the Christ's College (Canterbury) Amendment Act, 1910: And whereas such last-mentioned Act contains only six sections, and it was the intention of the promoter of the said Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928, to make reference to section six of the Christ's College (Canterbury) Amendment Act, 1910: And whereas it is expedient to amend the provisions of the said Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928, by deleting the word "eight" where it occurs in the last line of section two thereof, and substituting the word "six":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1929, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928.

2. Section two of the Christ's College (Canterbury) Act, 1928, is hereby amended by deleting the word "eight" appearing in the last line thereof, and substituting the word "six."
