A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Christchurch City Reserves Act, 1877. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch City Reserves Amendment Act, 1932-33, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch City Reserves Act, 1877 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. The principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from the First Schedule thereto the third paragraph of the said Schedule, being the description of the piece of land mentioned in the Schedule hereto. Schedule to principal Act amended.

3. The said piece of land mentioned in the Schedule hereto is hereby vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Christchurch, freed and discharged from all trusts, reservations, rights, or restrictions whatever. Portion of city reserves vested in Corporation freed from previous trusts.

ALL that plot of land situate on the west side of Cathedral Square, and known as the Godley Statue Block ; and bounded on the east by the curved portion of Colombo Street, and on the north, south, and west by roads one chain wide.
