A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Christchurch City Reserves Title. Act, 1877.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch City short Title. Reserves Amendment Act, 1932-33, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch City

10 Reserves Act, 1877 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. The principal Act is hereby amended by omitting Schedule to from the First Schedule thereto the third paragraph of principal Act amended. the said Schedule, being the description of the piece of 15 land mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

3. The said piece of land mentioned in the Schedule Portion of city hereto is hereby vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and reserves vested in Corporation Citizens of the City of Christchurch, freed and discharged freed from trusts, reservations, rights, or restrictions previous trusts. from all 20 whatever.
