# A BILL INTITULED

An Act for vesting certain Reserves in the Mayor, Title.

Councillors, and Citizens of Christchurch.

WHEREAS the parcels of land described in the Schedules hereto Preamble. are under the management of the City Council of Christchurch, and it is expedient that the same should be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the said city as hereinafter set forth:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Christchurch City Short Title. Reserves Act, 1877."

2. The parcels of land described in the First Schedule hereto Recreation grounds shall be and the same are hereby vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Christchurch, for the purpose of being used as recreation-grounds for the inhabitants of the City of Christchurch.

3. The parcels of land described in the Second Schedule hereto Lands in trust for 15 shall be and the same are hereby vested in the Mayor, Councillors, municipal purposes. and Citizens of Christchurch, in trust for the municipal purposes of the said city.

4. The parcels of land described in the Third Schedule hereto Market-place. shall be and the same are hereby invested in the Mayor, Councillors, 20 and Citizens of Christchurch, in trust for the purposes of a market-place.

All that plot of land extending from Worcester Street to Gloucester Street, and bounded on the South by Worcester Street, on the East and South-east by Oxford Terrace, and on the West and North-west by the River Avon.

All that plot of land extending from Colombo Street to Manchester Street, bounded on the South and South-west by Oxford Terrace, and on the North and Northeast by the River Avon.

All that plot of land extending from Manchester Street to Madras Street, and bounded on the South-east by Oxford Terrace, and on the North-west by the River Avon.

All that plot of land lying between Madras Street and Barbadoes Street, and bounded on the South-east by Oxford Terrace East, and on the North-west by the River Avon.

All that plot of land lying south of the Avon River, and bounded on the East by Madras Street, on the South by Chester Street, and on the North-west by Oxford Terrace East.
