A BILL INTITULED

An Act to repeal "The Contagious Diseases Act, 1869."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Contagious Diseases Act Short Title. 1869 Repeal Act, 1887."

2. "The Contagious Diseases Act, 1869," is hereby repealed: Contagious Diseases Provided that this repeal shall not affect—

(1.) Anything duly done or suffered under the Act hereby repealed;

(2.) Any penalty, forfeiture, or other punishment incurred in respect of any offence against the Act hereby repealed.

3. This Act shall come into operation within

from and after the passing thereof, on such day when Act to come as may be fixed for that purpose by Proclamation by the Governor, issued in the Government Gazette.
