10 AN ACT to amend the Christchurch Domains Act, 1904.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

15 1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1937, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch Domains Act, 1904. Short Title.

Section eleven of the Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1913, is hereby amended by omitting the words "two thousand five hundred pounds", and substituting the words "five thousand pounds" in the proviso to subsection one thereof. 4. The Christchurch Domain Board may, in every financial year, out of its General Fund or Account, expend for purposes not authorized by any Act or law for the time being in force any sum or sums not amounting in the whole to more than twenty-five pounds. 10
