A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to give the sanction of Law to the collection Title. of certain Duties of Customs collected in pursuance of a certain Resolution of the House of Representatives adopted on the 28th day of June, 1870.

THEREAS on the twenty-eighth day of June last the House of Preamble. Representatives resolved that, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, the duties of Customs specified in the second and third sections of this Act should, on and after the twenty-ninth

5 day of June last, be charged on the articles mentioned in the said sections: And whereas, since the adoption of such resolution, the said duties have been levied and collected: And whereas it is expedient to give the authority of law to the collection of such duties, and to authorize the collection thereof until the thirtieth day of 10 September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Customs Duties Short Title. 15 Validation Act 1870.'

2.
