Title
1. Short Title and commencement

1B. Jurisdiction

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Consumer Guarantees Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

10 *New*

1B. Jurisdiction—(1) Section 47 of the principal Act is amended by omitting from subsections (4) and (5) the expression “\$3,000” wherever it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “\$7,500”.

15 (2) Section 47 (6) of the principal Act is amended—

(a) By omitting the expression “\$3,000”, and substituting the expression “\$7,500”; and

(b) By omitting the expression “\$5,000”, and substituting the expression “\$12,000”.
