A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to continue "The Chinese Immigrants Act Amendment Act, 1888." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Chinese Immigrants Act Amendment Act Continuance Act, 1889." Short Title.

2. Section twelve of "The Chinese Immigrants Act Amendment Act, 1888," is hereby repealed, and the said Act shall continue in force until repealed by the General Assembly, except the said section. "Chinese Immigrants Act, 1888," perpetuated.
