A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Civil List Acts so far as relates to Salaries of Judges of the Supreme Court. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that further provision should be made for defraying the expenses of the salaries of Judges of the Supreme Court: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Civil List Acts Amendment Act, 1883." Short Title.

2. Instead of the sum of seven thousand seven hundred pounds granted to Her Majesty by "The Civil List Act, 1863," and appropriated to defraying the expenses of the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court by "The Civil List Act 1863 Amendment Act, 1873," there shall be payable to Her Majesty, for and during the year ending the *thirty-first* day of *March* next, and every year thereafter, out of the Consolidated Fund, the sum of nine thousand two hundred pounds. £9,200 appropriated for salaries of Judges of Supreme Court.

Such sum shall be applied in paying to the Judges of the Supreme Court the annual salaries specified in the Schedule hereto.
