A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to define the time when Acts of the Title.
General Assembly assented to by the
Governor shall come into operation.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Commencement of Acts Short Title. Act 1865.”

II. Every Act which shall hereafter be passed and every Act passed Acts assented to come into operation on the day on which assent is given. in the last Session of the General Assembly which shall not prescribe the time from which it is intended to take effect and which shall have been assented to in Her Majesty's name shall come into operation on the day on which it shall receive the Governor's assent.

III. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it shall receive the Governor's assent.
