A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Canterbury Provincial Vesting Act 1928

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 5 **1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Canterbury Provincial Buildings Vesting Amendment Act 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Canterbury Provincial Buildings Vesting Act 1928* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 (2) This Act shall come into force on the 14th day after the date on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

- 2. Provincial Buildings vested in Canterbury United Council**—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 7 (1), and substituting the following subsections:
- 15

“(1) The land described in the Schedules to this Act is hereby vested in the Canterbury United Council (hereafter in this Act referred to as the Board) for an estate in fee simple, in trust, to

maintain it and the Provincial Council Buildings on it as a memorial to the foundation of the Province of Canterbury.

“(1A) The District Land Registrar of the Land Registration District of Canterbury shall take all steps, and make all entries in the registers, necessary to give effect to subsection (1) of this section.” 5

(2) The Canterbury Provincial Buildings Board, established by section 2 (1) of the principal Act, is hereby abolished; and all property, rights, obligations, and liabilities it had immediately before the commencement of this Act are hereby declared to have become property, rights, obligations, and liabilities of the Canterbury United Council on that commencement. 10

(2A) Section 7 (3) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word “structural”. 15

(2B) Section 11 (1) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the word “The” and substituting the words “For the purposes of this Act, the ”.

(3) The principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by— 20

(a) Omitting from the Title the words “to constitute a Special Board and” and the word “therein”, and substituting for the word “therein” the words “in the Canterbury United Council”;

(b) Repealing sections 2 to 6, and 12. 25

New

(3A) The Official Information Act 1982 is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from the First Schedule the item “Canterbury Provincial Buildings Board”.

(4) The following enactments are hereby consequentially repealed: 30

(a) Section 17 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal Act 1962:

(b) Section 8 of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal Act 1976. 35
