A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to remove the Seat of Government of the Dominion to the City of Auckland. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

| <p>1. This Act may be cited as the Capital Site Act, 1909.</p> <p>2. On and after a day to be specified by the Governor by Proclamation the seat of Government of the Dominion shall be removed to the City of Auckland.</p> <p>3. The Minister of Public Works, out of funds to be appropriated by Parliament for the purpose, shall cause to be provided such public buildings in the City of Auckland as may be necessary for the conduct of public business.</p> <p>4. In order to raise funds for the purposes of this Act the Minister of Finance may from time to time borrow, under the New Zealand Loans Act, 1908, such moneys, not exceeding one hundred thousand pounds, at a rate not exceeding four per centum per annum.</p> <p>5. The Minister of Public Works is hereby authorised from time to time to sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of such of the public buildings situate in the City of Wellington as are rendered unnecessary by the removal of the seat of Government from that city, and shall apply the proceeds of such disposition in or towards the repayment of any moneys borrowed under the authority of this Act.</p> | <p>Short Title.</p> <p>Seat of Government.</p> <p>Public buildings to be provided.</p> <p>Power to borrow.</p> <p>Power to dispose of public buildings in Wellington.</p> |
